The dorms

How many students per room?

2 beds rooms or individual rooms. Rooms are single-sex.

Where are the dorms located?

- Grade 10: 9 minutes walking distance from the school («site Collégiale» to «site Université»)
- Grade 11 and 12: within the permises («site Université»)

Are outings allowed?

On Wednesday afternoons and 2 evenings per week if attending a club activity (11 pm curfew).

How is laundry managed?

During the weekend by host family. There are also machines at school if needed. Bed linen is provided by either the host family or school.
